Awards will be made to successful candidates subject to administrative requirements established by the Board of Trustees.

Applicants must be registered as full-time students.

## ELIGIBILITY & RULES

Any student who has graduated, is already attending school or who will be graduating from a High School or an equivalent program and will be attending or is already attending a recognized post-secondary institution, such as a College or University in the coming school year, and is a child/stepchild/grandchild of a Local 506 member in good standing, is eligible to apply for consideration.

Applicants must not be a dependent of an employee of LiUNA Local 506 or Local 506 Training Centre.

Should a member be deemed suspended, the applicant will not be considered.

Spouses of members are not eligible.

### Awards

University and College applicants will be evaluated separately.

Awards Breakdown:

**University Applicants:** 4 awards valued at \$3,000 each.

**College Applicants:** 4 awards valued at \$2,000 each.

Applicants will receive a letter in the mail, advising of the selection process.

### Criteria

An Independent Academic Committee will review all applications received.

## INSTRUCTIONS

### Grading Criteria

Scholarships will be awarded based on the following criteria:

- Essay Submission;
- Involvement in community activities including: multi-cultural, religious, athletics and any other organizations;
- Paid or volunteer work experience (with references) not including volunteer work done for school credits;
- Secondary school or University/ College marks and academic achievements;
- Life experience;
- Any additional information.

## Submission Instructions

Please take these steps to ensure that your application is received in full. **Only complete applications that are received on time will be considered:**

- Fill out the personal information form and attach any documents pertaining to community activity, paid work, or any relevant information.
- Please completely answer the essay portion, typed, and double-spaced.
- Copy of Academic Transcript from the Secondary school you last attended and College or University (including final marks-number of credits will not be accepted).
- Letter of acceptance from the College or University you will be attending in the upcoming academic year.
- Any other relevant documentation such as references, awards, etc.

## ESSAY COMPONENT

### Essay Format

Complete an essay on the topic listed below. Each essay should be a maximum of 500 words and must include information gathered from research as well as personal opinion. Please type and double space your essay, if typing is not possible neatly print and double space your work.

Each essay should be written in a standard format consisting of 5 paragraphs:

- 1 introductory paragraph.
- 3 body paragraphs - each reflecting a different point of the topic.
- 1 concluding paragraph.

### Academic Integrity Policy

All essays must be the original work of the applicant. Submissions that contain plagiarism, including copying from published sources or other individuals, will be disqualified.

The use of artificial intelligence tools (such as ChatGPT or similar platforms) to generate or substantially assist in writing the essay is not permitted. Essays must reflect the applicant's own ideas, voice, and effort.

Any essay found to be in violation of these guidelines will not be considered.
